The Springboro High School Percussion Ensemble

What Is It?

This year we will be fielding a competitive marching ensemble.

The percussion ensemble is comprised of primarily percussion instruments. Basically, if you take the winds and guard away from Marching Band, what is left would be a typical marching percussion ensemble. The ensemble also includes many other "non-wind" instruments. Pianos, synthesizers, guitars, electric bass and other string instruments may be used.

This ensemble begins shortly after the Marching Band season has ended.

We will also prepare various concert works for our annual Memorial Day Concert at North Park and The 2nd Annual Springboro Percussion Ensemble Evening of Percussion, on May 10.

Who Can Do It?

While the core of the ensemble is comprised of High School percussionists, the ensemble is open to all members of Springboro High School. If a student has the desire to work hard, develop new skills. and grow as a musician, then they are more than welcome to join. They need not be percussionists....yet!

How Long Is The Ensemble "In Season"?

Since the group is essentially two ensemble opportunities, we run throughout the rest of the school year. This is a breakdown of the year:

I. The Competitive Season

A. November - December: Clinics & Auditions and begin

B. Rehearsal Schedule:

1. Tuesday & Thursday 6:00 - 9:00, Saturday 9:00 - Noon

C."The Friday Rule"

- 1. If we perform Saturday morning, there will be a Friday rehearsal.
- 2. If we perform Friday afternoon or evening, rehearsal will be Saturday morning

D. Sunday performances

1. While we try to avoid Sunday activity, the circuits we compete in have events scheduled. It will be necessary to attend some Sunday events during the competitive season.

II. Percussion "Mini Camp"

Because we prepare during the school year, we do not have the benefit of a "Band Camp". In order to ensure we are ready for the competitions, we will have one or two "Mini-Camps". These camps will start on a Friday after school and resume on the following day. The exact dates will be announced as soon as possible.

Attendance is mandatory!

III. ATTENDANCE POLICY

Because everyone is vital to the success of the group, **all rehearsals are required.** The only excused absences will be:

Personal Illness
Death in the family

Other issues will be handled on a case to case basis and may affect your participation in the ensemble.

All attendance notifications need to be directed to Mr. Runge. Simply telling another student is not acceptable and will not be tolerated. In the event a rehearsal is missed, parent contact is required.
